
SUBJECT: Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Annual Leave Carryover

1. The 2010 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) and Department of Defense (DoD) Financial Management Regulation (FMR) 7000.14-R temporarily increased the annual leave carryover benefit to 75 days. The 2013 NDAA extends this temporary increase until 30 Sep 15. The Ohio Army National Guard cannot predict whether or not a future NDAA or DoD FMR will authorize further extension of this temporary increase. **As of the date of this correspondence, AGR Soldiers will lose annual leave in excess of 60 days on 30 Sep 15.**

2. Supervisors must analyze AGR Soldier annual leave balances and leave plans to mitigate the risk of losing accrued annual leave. Leave is an entitlement that must be planned and scheduled to obtain the maximum benefit for individual Soldiers, balanced with organizational mission and readiness requirements.
