Summary of Duties and Responsibilities: The selected officer is assigned to US European Command (EUCOM) -- J5 Branch, with duty at the Office of Defense Cooperation (ODC) within the US Embassy Budapest. The officer is responsible for managing EUCOM's Mil-to-Mil Program for the country of Hungary and serve as the liaison to the State Partnership Program with Ohio. The officer will be assigned additional duties and responsibilities by the ODC Chief as required. Please note: the officer will be required to wear professional business attire in addition to service and Air Battle Uniform while assigned to duty at the U.S. Embassy Budapest.

Applicants must possess excellent interpersonal skills and cultural expertise to gain credibility and facilitate interaction with foreign delegates, Department of State (DoS), Department of Defense (DoD) officials and other government agencies.

BAO must attend the Security Cooperation Management – Overseas (SCM-O) course conducted at the Defense Institute of Security Cooperation Studies, Wright Patterson AFB, prior to orders start date.

Permanent Change of Station orders for eligible family members is contingent upon receiving command sponsorship approval from United States European Command. Command sponsorship requests require a medical evaluation of all family members to ensure adequate care is available in the host nation.

Selected applicant must receive TAG approval and a TAG release letter prior to submitting a request for Title 10 orders for this tour.
