SUBJECT: Title 10 Active Duty Operational Support (ADOS) Announcement #16-006, National Guard Bureau (NGB) NG-J32, Counterdrug (CD) Analysis and Fusion Subject Matter Expert (SME) and Instructor

1. The NGB J32 CD Division within the NGB Joint Staff requires a highly qualified Army or Air National Guardsman to serve in the Title 10 ADOS program. The tour will be for a minimum of one (1) year at National Guard Bureau, 111 South George Mason Drive, AHS2, Arlington, Virginia 22204-1373. The individual selected will serve under the authority of Title 10 USC, Section 12301(d).
2. Position Responsibilities: Serve as a subject matter expert (SME) and Instructor in the Analysis and Fusion Section for NG-J32 Counterdrug Division, J3/7 Domestic Operations and Force Development Directorate, NGB Joint Staff. Responsible for maintaining curriculum, validating instructor pool and coordinating training for assistant instructors. Facilitate and execute Criminal Analysis Phase I and II courses as necessary to ensure qualified CD mission 2B personnel at state level. Ensure relevant and professional training is consistent with DOD and TRADOC guidelines. Collaborate and plan with DOD, NGB, state CD representatives, and various law enforcement agencies to identify and fill training requirements.
3. Applicants must have a thorough knowledge of the CD 2B mission, proven analytical, writing and oral presentation skills. Must have working knowledge of the following analytical tools: Analyst Notebook, cellphone link analysis, cell phone data extraction, GIS, and open source analysis.
4. Duty Location: Arlington, Virginia.
5. Prerequisites:
 - a. Grade: E6 – E7.
 - b. Minimum of 5 years experience as a National Guard Counterdrug Analyst supporting active narcotics cases from start to finish. Examples of experience should be outlined in letter of recommendation from law enforcement supervisor.
 - c. AFSC/MOS: Immaterial. ASI: T9/SEI: 069

d. Security Clearance: Top Secret/SCI.

e. Instructor qualified

f. Current member of the Army or Air National Guard.

6. Reference the attached Counterdrug ADOS Checklist for application requirements. Application instruction compliance is critical to the selection process, i.e. packages must arrive on time and contain all required data. For quality and fairness, NG-J32 cannot process applications that do not have the required data, meet stated criteria, or arrive after the closeout date.
