5. Brig Gen Botchie discussed energy conservation measures at Rickenbacker and Manning Document update.

- 5.1. Gen Botchie and the Energy Management Steering Group conducted a walk through of the base on 4 December 2007. He thanked the LPC for their work with the energy conservation measures, but stated that Governor Strickland has dictated that all state agencies reduce twenty-percent usage in five years with the

base-line starting point of FY07 (state energy budget FY runs from June thru July). Governor Strickland also requested an Emergency Operation On-Call list by 15 December. Closed Item.

5.2. The Manning Document for AGR's and Technicians will take affect in April 2008. Currently there are forty-one temporary Technician indefinites, and the wing needs to work on getting them in to the permanent slots. Management will conduct a meeting following a trip to the bureau to meet with Jeff Louis about the ARW manning document. The goal is to have an organized manning document plan by 1 January. Closed Item.

6. The Co-Leaders Selection has been put on hold until the January meeting. Open Item.

7. Mike Troxel briefed the LPC on a future visit of contract representatives from Minot, North Dakota, that will look at each building on base to give energy saving suggestions. He also stated that the base has saved so much in gas since 2005, that our major cost now is electricity. Open Item.

8. The next LPC meeting will be 9 January at 1400 in the Wing Conference Room.
