4. Old Business

A. At the last meeting, it was brought up that a recorder was needed for these meetings. Brent Leimenstoll stated that Melissa McClellan volunteered for the position. The committee voted to accept her as the recorder and all agreed.

B. Dan Roche had some items that were showing as "current" and needed a status on:

1. 180-06-04 14 Feb 06 **Wing Hats**

Wing hats were approved for local wear and are in the process of being approved/disapproved by ANG. Jeff Brubaker is handling this. This issue will probably go away when the ABUs are phased in.

Status: Closed.

2. 180-06-05 14 Feb 06 **Energy Conservation**

The conservation plan was discussed and a comprehensive plan was developed to deal with it. Bill Giezie was running with that issue being the Civil Engineer so he could tell

you more when he returns from overseas. This is still an ongoing item, but the implementation plan is closed. We get monthly briefs on the status of energy usage and cost.

3. 180-06-06 11 Apr 06 **Flag @ Half Staff**

This was a request to inform the base populace of when and why the flag will be at half staff.

Status: Closed.

4. 180-06-07 11 Apr 06 **Ops Weight Room**

The base populace is now permitted to use the weight room in Operations. Mark Bartman said he would send out an email to the base to let them know how they can gain access to the weight room (i.e. the hours, how to get the key from Mark Close).

Status: Closed with letter being sent out.

5. 180-06-08 11 Apr 06 **Collection for the Beale's**

The collection for Barry Beale was approved and completed.

Status: Closed.

6. 180-06-11 11 Jul 06 **Front Gate Hours**

Front gate hours were set to open at 6AM because that is when the shift change for Security Police occurs.

Status: Closed.

7. 180-06-15 11 Jul 06 **Wing Plaques**

It was decided that this is not a LPC issue. Funds for this would have to come from some local council.

Status: Closed.

8. 180-06-16 19 Dec 06 **LM Training – Danko**

Mike Danko still needs the newer training primarily in the IBB process.

Status: Open.

9. 180-06-18 19 Dec 06 **Hiring Board Training**

The PEC was going to look deeper into boards so it was decided to defer until the PEC comes out with guidelines.

Status: Closed until the PEC completes further review.

10. 180-06-19 19 Dec 06 **ACFT in chocks / Night Flying**

Operations scheduler said that they would make every attempt to comply with this request.

Status: Closed (for now).

11. 180-06-21 19 Dec 06 **Technician v Military TDY**

It was decided that each individual Group decides whether or not to fund deployments in technician status knowing that if they do, then, the funds would come out of that Group.

Status: Closed.

5. New Business

A. The committee reviewed the proposal which requests a condensed work week schedule. They checked for any grammatical errors. Note: Michael Masiker said that the letter would be put on official letterhead and will have the correct approving official filled in. Currently, the proposal just has "TO:XXX" but it will have either TAG or HRO official filled in – he would find out from Dan Roche.

Mike Haas moved to accept the letter and forward it to the appropriate officials.

Victor Kynard seconded the motion.

All committee members approved.

B. Brent Leimenstoll reminded the committee that his management co-chair responsibilities ends in two months. He was looking for a new person to take over as the co-chair. Michael Masiker volunteered to be the interim co-chair until William Giezie returns in two months. In June, the new co-chair needs to be decided.

C. At the next meeting, the committee needs to decide if they will hold a June and a July meeting due to several members being unable to attend due to a deployment.
