4. Old Business

A. Energy Update – Giezie was not available - no briefing given. **ALWAYS AN OPEN ITEM.**

B. Late Appraisals – reviewed [current list](#). **ALWAYS AN OPEN ITEM.**

C. LPC Review – Dailey. [LPC 3 \(Smoking Shelters\)](#) – Rewrite. Postponed until item D is resolved. **OPEN ITEM (MAY 07)**

D. Repairing Smoke Shacks. UFR Status. Nordhaus said that the UFR was funded with ORI funds. The shelters should be coming soon. He will check with Finance. Also, CE still needs to inspect the current shacks to see if they want to keep any of them to use for bus stops, etc. Plus, still need to rewrite LPC 3 and determine new “legal” locations for the shelters (i.e. can't place where smoke flows into buildings). **OPEN ITEM (APR 08).**

E. Working thru Lunch – Status. Discrepancy between what was voted on from last “special” meeting versus what was sent out. Is there still a flexibility option of 30, 45, 60 minute lunches for night shift OR is it mandated that you must take 45 minutes during the night shift? Discussion was that it is a mandated 45-minute lunch break; however, employees can still work with their supervisors if they want to adjust it and supervisor authorizes it. Note: If taking a 60-minute lunch, employee has to work 15 minutes later. If taking a 30-minute lunch, employee gets to leave 15 minutes early. Will need to review LPC 8 at next meeting to see if the guidance needs to be included. **OPEN ITEM (SEP 09)**

F. Quick Turn Launch – Status. One has been accomplished and will continue to do the quick-turns on one Wednesday per month. No issues. Item closed.

### 3. New Business

A. Smokeless Tobacco Usage on base – Reagan. There is an AFI (reference wasn’t given during meeting) that says you can’t have tobacco within the industrial areas. Shouldn’t that include smokeless tobacco (aka “chew”)? Could incorporate this guidance into the wing supp issued against AFI 21-101 to make it applicable to technicians. Or, come to some sort of agreement within LPC. If you can’t smoke in an industrial area, why can you chew? Need to get exact references and bring back to next meeting. **OPEN ITEM (JAN 10)**

B. Moving Night Flying the week after the 180 Day Meeting – Nordhaus. Need immediate action on this but quorum not met by labor (only 2 representatives). Send out the vote thru email to move the week of night flying (7 Feb) to the week of 22. Leimenstoll would send out the email. **OPEN ITEM (JAN 10)**

C. 2 Turn/2 Turn on Friday – Belli is looking at flying on Fridays with utilizing technicians that want comp and ASA personnel as needed. CDDAR/hydrazine teams members would only be recalled if emergencies. No objections. Item closed.
