### Opening:

1<sup>st</sup> Lt Roche opened the meeting.

### Old Business:

1. Minutes from the 8 Feb 2006 Air PEC meeting were accepted with no changes.
2. LPC Updates: There are new members coming on to the 179<sup>th</sup> and 121<sup>st</sup> LPCs. LPC Training was briefly discussed, and a target was set to bring training to the Wings starting mid-July 2006.
3. State Budget: The budget has been fixed for the current Fiscal Year. The next FY starts 1 July 2006, and projections start us off with a \$1.2 million shortfall. The Adjutant General is addressing this with the State Legislature and the Office of Budget and Management. Accordingly, energy conservation continues to be an important topic.

### New Business:

1. Air Force Budget: The budget from the Air Force is very tight, and will likely get tighter in the future. Every dollar in support of one program is coming from another program somewhere else.
2. Technician Budget: The technician budget is also very tight. Responses to date have included voluntary LWOP and terminating temporary technicians. Guidance is expected soon to provide a more consistent response to the issue. A reduction in flying hours is possible. Maintaining the full-time force is a priority. Obtaining information from NGB is also difficult as all the interested parties are not always included in the information loop
