*1. Previous Minutes, LPC Metrics, Issue Metric* *Standing Item*  
The minutes from 29 November 2011 were reviewed. No changes were requested.

The LPC metrics were reviewed. BG Harris expressed his appreciation to the LPC's for their continued dedication to the partnership process.

A few changes were made to the LPC membership. It was determined that the LPC representing the CSMS is also covering the RTI, three brigades and the USPFO Warehouse. It was determined that the name of the CSMS LPC will be changed to DSCC LPC to more accurately reflect its issue coverage.
