

MEMORANDUM FOR Local Partnership Council Co-Chairs

SUBJECT: Partnership Leadership Presence during Local Council Meetings

1. We agree to be available by teleconference during Local Partnership Council (LPC) meetings to address partnership procedures and practices in this agency. We will not act to resolve issues in this forum. We will be available to act in an advisory capacity to interpret the Collective Bargaining Agreement and current or past practices in order for the LPCs to make informed decisions that compliment the intentions of labor and management at the senior level. We offer this not to bypass the Air or Army Service PECs.
2. LPC co-chairs desiring a teleconference are required to make such a request through the Labor Relations Specialist (LRS) as soon as possible but no less than 45 days in advance of scheduled LPC meetings. LPC co-chairs are responsible for continually keeping the LRS informed of LPC meeting dates, times and locations. LPC's are responsible for acquiring and operating equipment and facilities to support teleconferences.
