Preference will be given to members currently in 5J0X1. Manages and performs legal functions not prohibited by statute and the Lawyers' Manual on Professional Conduct. Performs paraprofessional and legal research functions under the supervision of a judge advocate in connection with civil law, military justice, and claims activities. Provides legal assistance to military members to include Wills and Powers of Attorney. Related DoD Occupational Subgroup: 512.

Knowledge is mandatory of: keyboard and microcomputer operation; UCMJ and MCM; English grammar and composition; math; functional organization of a military legal office; interviewing techniques and knowledge of legal procedures concerning military courts and boards; legal terminology and interpretations; research and utilization of legal publications and reference files; civil law matters; Air Force organization and administration; and office management.

Education. For entry into this specialty, completion of high school, and completion of college level courses in English comprehension, math, and computers is desirable.

Retraining Requirements: Applicant must currently hold a 5-level in their current AFSC, have a score of 51 or higher on the AFQT, ability to type 25 wpm, no previous convictions by court-martial or Article 15, no convictions by a civilian court except for minor traffic violations, and a passing PT score.
