DUTIES:

Selectee will be trained to be Combat Mission Ready for the F-16 Fighter Aircraft. Must be able to enter Flight Training prior to their 33rd birthday as well as pass a "Medical Flying Class I" physical with no physical defects, and no age waiver. Flight training is expect to be processed for late Fiscal Year (FY) 22 or beyond; 1 July 2022 or later. Selectee will be worldwide deployable at the completion of training.

EVALUATION PROCESS:

Evaluation will be based on the information provided and meeting a Selection Review Board tentatively scheduled to convene **October of 2021**. AF/ANG core values will be incorporated into the interview process.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

- Bachelor's degree (Non College graduate: Must show proof that applicant is in their junior year of undergraduate studies and provide a letter stating intentions and plans to complete undergraduate degree within the next 18 months)
- Meet all requirements according to the Air Force Officer Classification Directive
- Meet minimum AFOQT scores - Pilot and Nav scores must equal minimum composite of 50 with a degree, or 90 without a degree
- Hold a current FAA Medical Certificate, Class I (preferred), II, or III
- Have completed at least a solo flight toward Private Pilot Certificate.

- Resume & Cover Letter (1 page maximum each)
- College Transcript (certified copy)
- 112FS Pilot Candidate Form V4
- Official AFOQT scores (print out)
- Basic Aviation Test Scores (PCSM Score print out)
- FAA Pilot Certificate, if one is held (copy of both sides)
- Proof of solo flight if an FAA Certificate is not held (copy of log book entry)
- Current FAA Medical Certificate (copy)
