### DUTIES:

When Airmen or their families are suffering from sever medical conditions or injuries, it's imperative they get comprehensive care. Responsible for executing complex, intensive nursing care, Critical care Nurse provide the immediate treatment needed in severe situations. An important position whatever they're located, the quick and expert actions of these skilled nurse can make the difference when it comes to saving a person's life.

### EDUCATION:

For entry into AFSC 46N1E, meet the entry level education requirements for appointment to the Nurse Corps for Active Duty, Air Force Reserve and Air National Guard. Must be a graduate of a baccalaureate degree program in nursing (BSN) accredited by a national nursing accrediting agency recognized by the US Department of Education. Registered nurses who are graduates of an associate's degree in nursing (ADN) and no do not have a BSN are not eligible for accession unless they also have a post-baccalaureate (masters or doctorate) degree in nursing that is also nationally accredited and recognized by the US Department of Education <https://www.ed.gov/accreditation>.

### EVALUATION PROCESS:

Evaluation will be based on the information provided and meeting a selection board, date to be determined.

## **MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:**

Nurses selected must have a minimum of twelve months Registered Nursing and six months Critical Care/ Emergency Department experience. Within six months prior to the application, the nurses must have experience with ventilator management (ABG interpretation, basic ventilator management), hemodynamic monitoring (knowledge and management of invasive lines, interpretation and application of labs/data, fluid/ blood product management, and resuscitation standards) and titration of vasoactive intravenous medications. Nurses must demonstrate knowledge in pharmacology of commonly used medications include, but not limited to: medication dose and use, contraindications, management and clinical indication for medications. IAW AFI 48-307 V2 - Nurses will be current with BLS, ACLS, as well as Advanced Trauma Care for Nurses (ATCN) Course; or, Trauma Nurses Core Course (TNCC) in lieu of ATCN.
