DUTIES:

Support the free exercise of religion provision of the first amendment of the US Constitution. Conducts worship services, liturgies, and rites. Provides counseling, pastoral care, unit engagement, religious education, morale programs, spiritual renewal, lay leadership programs, and humanitarian outreach opportunities. Advises leadership at all levels on spiritual, religious, ethical, moral, morale, and quality of life matters. Maintains regular communication with endorsing officials and submits professional reports and records as required. Attends endorser-sponsored training and conference events as required by endorsing officials.

EVALUATION PROCESS:

Evaluation will be based on the information provided and meeting a selection board, date to be determined.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

Knowledge of Air Force vision, values, organization, policy, and mission is mandatory, in addition to Chaplain Corps mission, vision, organization, guidance, programs, and readiness requirements. A baccalaureate degree with not less than 120 semester hours (180 quarter hours) of undergraduate credit from a qualifying educational institution as defined in DoDI 1304.28. Master of Divinity or equivalent theological degree from an accredited educational institution; or 3 years of equivalent resident graduate study according to DoD Directive 1304.28.
