DUTIES:

This position is located in an Air Control Squadron. Selectees are responsible for the planning and execution of Control and Reporting Center intelligence functions during all phases of operations. Directs activities to collect, analyze, exploit, produce, and disseminate intelligence information to CRC operators. Provides written guidance to conduct and develop unit intelligence training with sufficient frequency, consistency and accuracy to ensure personnel knowledge, skills and abilities to the CRC mission remain current and operational. Deploy in support of expeditionary air control squadron operations.

EVALUATION PROCESS:

Evaluation will be based on the information provided and meeting a selection board, date to be determined.
