DUTIES:

Applicants must meet the minimum eligibility criteria as stated in AFI 36-2113. Must be within physical fitness standards and project an overall image that exceeds minimum standards. This position is the principal advisor to the commander on all issues related to the enlisted force and exercises general supervision over assigned enlisted personnel. Knowledge is mandatory of: personnel management with emphasis on quality force indicators, personnel and administration; military training; Air Force organization; drill and ceremonies; customs and courtesies; sanitation and hygiene; military justice; and counseling techniques.

EVALUATION PROCESS:

Evaluation will be based on the information provided and meeting a selection board, date to be determined.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

Must be MSgt promotable to SMSgt by the close of the announcement. Must have SNCOA completed by the close of the announcement. Must be currently serving as a First Sergeant or served in the 8F000 SDI. Must not have been removed from the SDI for cause. Must remain in the position a minimum of 2 years. Must have served as a First Sergeant for at least one year Must have or be able to attain 36 months of retainability. Must speak distinctly and without speech impediments. Must have scored 75 or above on their last fitness test, no failure on any portion within the last 12 months. Additionally, must have no current PT exemptions with the exception of those due to pregnancy and/or deployment. Must possess a Community College of the Air Force degree or equivalent from an accredited institution. No referral EPRs in the last three years.

Successful application will be assigned to compatible military position in an appropriate unit of assignment in the Ohio Air National Guard as shown above. If officer, this position is being announced in accordance with OHPD-011, *Ohio Air National Guard Officer Assignments Policy*, 24 April 2015, and is a Traditional Guardsman (part-time) employment opportunity.

The position POC is responsible for selecting the board members, scheduling interviews, submitting the board's recommendation to the commander, and notification of the commander's selection/non-selection. The position POC is required to complete and return this form and the OHANG Form 3, E-6 to E-9 Selection Board form to the Recruiting Office Manager (ROM) within 30 days of selection.
