**DUTIES:**

Plans and organizes maintenance activities. Plans and supervises system installation and evaluates facilities layout and performance standards. Designs and develops organizational structures and determines equipment, training and supplies required for systems implementation and support. Executes operational plans to ensure positive control of assigned forces. Evaluates operational readiness of ground radar and airfield systems equipment, and related support equipment. Directs maintenance activities. Directs personnel employed in siting, deploying, inspecting, adjusting, removing, replacing, and repairing RAWs, and related equipment. Prepares and analyzes reports encompassing siting, deploying, maintaining, installing, repairing and removing RAWs and related equipment. Coordinates activities and resolves common problems. Directs overhaul and repair of RAWs and related equipment. Ensures work standards are maintained. Determines extent and economy of repair, including disposition of malfunctioning equipment. Inspects and evaluates maintenance activities for compliance with directives. Evaluates, rates, and prepares reports on activity effectiveness. Recommends and implements corrective action for improved methods and procedures. Evaluates effectiveness of equipment usage, systems performance, customer service, supplies, and system scheduling, processing, and maintenance.
