Prepares manual and Computer Aided Design (CAD) drawings, Building Information Modeling (BIM) solutions, construction contract specifications, and cost estimates. Operates and maintains Geographic Information Systems (GIS). Utilizes surveying technology to include Global Positioning System (GPS). Evaluates potential construction sites and performs field tests on soils, asphalt, and concrete. IAW duties and responsibilities outlined in the AFECD.
